**Historic Hibernian Hall** was built in 1913 as a social club and dance venue for recently arriving Irish immigrants and in the 1960's it became the headquarters for Opportunities Industrialization Center, a vocational training program created to uplift the community. Acquired by MPDC, the building and its **beautiful 2 story ballroom** with sweeping arched windows was fully restored to its original grandeur in 2005, opening for the Roxbury neighborhood as an innovative arts and culture venue.

Today, Hibernian Hall provides **affordable access to culturally relevant performing arts** and nurtures Roxbury's artistic community with year-round **theater, dance, music, media, and spoken word**. It presents local arts ensembles such as the classical music performing group Castle of Our Skins, which celebrates Black artistry, and it produces important theatre, like Lydia Diamond's award winning "Stick Fly" and Actors' Shakespeare Projects' "Nat Turner in Jerusalem." In addition, Hibernian Hall **collaborates with highly regarded arts groups** such as Boston Children's Chorus, New Repertory Theater and Celebrity Series of Boston to present their original work.
