About The OIC

OIC, a nonprofit agency specializing in job training for disadvantaged communities across the nation, operated its Greater Boston training facility inside of Hibernian Hall from April 1968 until the doors closed in the early 1980s.

The OIC's skeleton key logo promised "To Open Any Door," and its programming opened doors for participants with Allstate, IBM, and other local businesses. Trainees received instruction in auto repair, keypunch, electrical, and other entry-level skills.

In 2020, MPDC will kick-off its first Pilot Construction Workforce Program, *Train 2 Trades,* in partnership with Madison Park Vocational Technical High School, mirroring the OIC model from the 60s.


