Enrichment opportunities including dance, cooking, STEM projects, visual arts, and sports and fitness. While field trips include visits to museums, parks, pools, beaches, science and nature centers, libraries and much more. They also have partnerships with Haley House, Tenacity, Einc, and the South End library. All students receive breakfast, lunch, and snack at no cost to families.
